NSF 51

NSF/ANSI Standard 51 establishes minimum public health and sanitation requirements for finishes used in the manufacture of commercial food service equipment and its components. The requirements of this standard are intended to ensure that the composition and surface finish of food equipment materials are such that a material will not adulterate food nor render food equipment difficult to clean and sanitize.

This means products such as broilers, beverage dispensers and stocks pots, and components such as tubing, gaskets and valves can all be protected with quality NSF certified powder coatings that also boast great sustainability credentials.

IFS Coatings' NSF/ANSI 51 certified powder coatings are available as single coat applications and come in a range of colors including black, blue, beige - brown, gray, green, red, white and yellow.

NSF 61

NSF 61/ANSI Standard 61 applies to materials and coatings used in the manufacture of equipment that comes into contact with either potable water or products that support the production of potable water. This means that manufacturers of metal pipes, tanks, fittings, valves and faucets can specify these approved IFS powder coatings and protect parts that contact drinking water, drinking-water chemicals or both, with an environmentally responsible, NSF certified powder coating.

IFS Coatings' NSF/ANSI 61 certified powder coatings are available as single coat applications and come in a range of colors including black, blue, brown, gray, green, red, white and yellow.

The National Sanitation Foundation, or NSF, is accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), so you will often see the specifications listed as NSF/ANSI.

The NSF was founded in 1944, with a stated mission “to protect and improve global human health.” As part of their work, NSF develops public health standards and certifications that help protect food, water, consumer products and the environment. They are an independent, accredited organization, and test, audit and certify products and systems as well as provide education and risk management.
