Description: *PLSF 20053, RAL 5002 Ultramarine Blue* is a Polyester-TGIC Powder coating designed for interior or exterior applications.

Application Data: *PLSF 20053, RAL 5002 Ultramarine Blue* can be applied with a corona electrostatic powder spray gun at between 60kv – 100 kV or fluidized bed.

Cure Schedule: *PLSF 20053, RAL 5002 Ultramarine Blue* can be cured in a direct or indirect gas convection oven, an electric oven, or an Infrared. A combination of any of these ovens is also suitable.

Std. Cure: 10 minutes @ 340°F Peak Metal Temperature

Storage: *PLSF 20053, RAL 5002 Ultramarine Blue* should be stored at temperatures below 80°F, in a dry area away from any heat source.

Notes: All tests were performed on B-1000 iron phosphated panels with a nominal film thickness of 2.0-3.0 mils. Please refer to the SDS for safety information.

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
